With unfamiliarity and high probability of hostile firing from ground made the task even more daunting. As he approached the landing zone with 24 troops on board, the helicopter came under intense firing by automatic weapons from all directions. Displaying immaculate presence of mind, he immediately ordered retaliatory fire which inflicted heavy damage to the hostile elements. Displaying exceptional courage, he skilfully carried out evasive manoeuvres from firing zone. His aircraft sustained 35 bullet hit marks causing damage to critical systems and injuring six troops, including the flight engineer in the cockpit. The bullet hits damaged the left fuel transfer pump and the flight gunner reported heavy leak in the cargo compartment. There was heavy fuel leak inside the helicopter with an imminent threat of fire and explosion. Shortly afterwards, the other fuel transfer pump also failed and the fuel dropped to critical levels. Undeterred and unfazed, he remained calm and focused and took timely decision to divert to the nearest helipad at a distance of 22 kms, and recovered the helicopter and all personnel safely. In a remarkable display of leadership and tactical acumen, Shri AneeshA S, AC, mobilized his team and moved forward with his buddy and scout engaging the Naxals group, concealed behind large and sturdy boulders up ahead. Despite the valiant retaliation by commanders and troops near the hilltop's foothill, the intense firing from the Naxals' well-fortified position

prevented the further advance of the troops. Recognizing the deadlock caused by the heavy and indiscriminate fire from the left side of the hilltop and considering the approaching dusk, Shri AneeshA S, AC, took decisive action and directed ShBibhor Kumar Singh, AC, to provide flanking support to break through the impasse.

In response to the situation, Sh Kumar Bibhor Singh, AC, demonstrated unwavering determination and fearlessness. Along with his team consisting of HC/RO Shri Surendra Kumar Yadav, and others, he proceeded from the right side to provide flanking support to Team No 01, which was trapped near the hilltop's foothill. They advanced by crawling and firing towards the Naxals, displaying great courage and selflessness despite the imminent danger.

However, the Naxals remained entrenched behind secure covers of boulders and trees, and their defenses were further bolstered by strategically placed command and pressure IEDs. Assessing the critical hazardous situation prioritizing the safety of his team, Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, and HC/RO Shri Surender Kumar Yadav continued to advance and fire relentlessly, putting their own life at risk. To counter the Naxals attack, Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, took bold action and directed to fire UBGL at the Naxal positions. This audacious action caused the collapse of the Naxals' fortifications, shattering their morale and instilling fear, leading to their retreat from the encounter site. As the Naxals retreated, they continued firing incessantly upon the troops, using

the cover of boulders and trees to evade capture.

During the strong counter offensive attack against the Naxals, ShriBibhor Kumar Singh, AC, along with HC/RO Shri Surendra Kumar Yadav and HC/GD Shri Suman Kumar Pandey, came under the impact of IED blast triggered by the Naxals. As a result, Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, and HC/RO Shri Surendra Kumar Yadav sustained severe and critical injuries. Despite the gravity of the wounds, Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, displayed remarkable bravery and continued to lead and direct his troops with unwavering determination, even in the face of a life-threatening situation.

Notwithstanding his critical condition, Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, fearlessly, exemplified extraordinary valor, courage, and strength, even after losing his left foot. Undeterred by his impaired mobility, he maintained his firing position behind cover and continued to provide covering fire to support his troop's further advancement. Despite unimaginable pain and agony, he ensured zero vacuums in command and control, and continued to give vital directions to the troops effectively, The unparalleled leadership and unwavering resolve of Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, served as a tremendous inspiration to all those around him.

As a result of their courageous efforts, the troops of 205 CoBRA successfully reached the hilltop and gained control of the dominating position. The Naxals were compelled to fall back, but while retreating they continued to fire

			intermittently. In retaliation, the troops of 205 CoBRA responded with a strong counter attack and their brave actions and collective effort turned the tide, forcing the Naxals to retreat resulting in securing the hilltop by the forces. The remarkable determination and leadership of Shri Bibhor Kumar Singh, AC, along with the unwavering resolve of the troops, ensured the success of the operation, despite the challenging circumstances. During the operation, large quantities of IED making materials were recovered from the incident site.

Srinagar	J&K Police	On 14.06.2022 a specific input was received from an asset of (PC) Srinagar regarding movement/presence of unknown terrorist/s carrying illegal arms/ammunition in Bemina area of District Srinagar. It was also revealed that the terrorist/s have plans to carry out fidayeen attack type activity on NHW from Pantha Chowk Parimpora axis by attacking police/ SFs/ convoy/ deployment in the wake of the Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra 2022. Acting on the tip-off and to get the positive location/ proper identification of the terrorist/s, immediately Police teams of District Srinagar/ Police Component Srinagar were constituted and deployed to the area. In order to chase the terrorist/s, avoid any untoward incident and to take appropriate action, a small team led by Shri Mohan Lal, Dy SP, Police Component, Srinagar established a special Naka at JVC Bernina Bypass, Srinagar. The officer along-with his buddies positioned at the front of

ambush party so as to cover up the most possible route which was leading to nearby the SKIMS Bernina (JVC), which always remains abuzz of patients and their attendants besides common civilian. The installation could have been exploited by terrorist/s to escape or to carry-out their nefarious designs after confronting with the police party. The terrorist/s being a 'fidayeen squad' when reached near the naka/ambush, resorted to indiscriminate firing on the naka party and ran towards the nearby build-up area flanked by the Government hospital on one side and a CRPF Camp on the other side.

Shri Mohan Lal, Dy SP alongwith his buddies kept on advancing towards the targeted area amid operational tactics and soon after the officer and his buddy reached closer, the hiding terrorists suspected their movement and lobbed grenades amid indiscriminate firing towards the officer and his buddy resulting into multiple splinter injuries to the officer, However, the officer while displaying incomparable bravery & uncommon courage and without caring for his life even after getting injured removed his buddy from the firing area.

Further leading his team from the front amid displaying exemplary leadership, the officer Shri Mohan Lal, Dy SP remained firm and showed nerves of steel. In order to restrict the movement of terrorists towards the Government hospital where civilian, patients/attendants including women and children were present and to avoid any hostage like situation at the said installation, the officer challenged the terrorists.

The terrorists in retaliation opened discriminate fire besides lobbed grenades towards the officer. The officer, sensing imminent threat to the lives of civilians, kept on advancing in the volley of fire, without caring for his personal life and displaying indomitable courage and neutralized 01 terrorist in a face of gunfight from very close range with his personal weapon and inflicted injuries to the 2nd terrorist. The identification of the eliminated terrorist was later on revealed as terrorist Commander "Rahi Bhai @ Abdullah Gojri, R/O Pakistan an "A+" category terrorist of LeT outfit". Arms/ammunition was recovered from the possession of slain terrorist.

Shri Mohan Lal while displaying uncommon courage moved towards the nearby area leading his small team where the 2nd terrorist had taken refuge behind a cemented structure after being injured. Noticing the movement of police team, the terrorist opened indiscriminate firing besides lobbing grenades resulting into injuries to some other personnel. At this stage, sensing imminent threat to the lives of his team members, Shri Mohan Lal without caring for his life, left his and advanced cover bravely towards the terrorist and neutralized him with his assault rifle from a very close range, The identification of the said eliminated terrorist was later on revealed as "Adil Hussain Mir @ Musaib S/o Altaf Hussain Mir R/o Liver Srigufwara Anantnag, a Pakistan trained "B" category terrorist of LeT outfit. These eliminated terrorists were involved in a number of terror attacks in the valley. The operation

			was concluded without any collateral damage and elimination of these terrorists is a big jolt to LeT terrorist network in South/ Central Kashmir Range. The instant anti-terrorist operation at Bemina near JVC Srinagar, falling within the J/D of P/S Bernina was one of the most daunting and challenging owing to presence of terrorists in a very critical location adjacent to 02 sensitive installations viz; Government Hospital on one side and CRPF Camp on other side. The whole operation concluded successfully without any collateral damage due to exceptional and conspicuous bravery, commitment to duty, indomitable will and

In order to get the positive location/proper identification of the terrorists, police teams of District Srinagar/Police Component Srinagar/Valley QAT CRPF/24 RR were constituted immediately to identify the exact location and to neutralize the terrorists without any collateral damage. The teams so constituted started intensifying search in the said area and succeeded in the zeroing of the house wherein the terrorist was hiding. In the meantime, the

Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector alongwith his buddy identified and located the target house and placed initial cordon. The houses inside the cordon were separated by either high tin sheets or by big boundary walls. In order to move from one house to another, he had to cross these barriers under constant threat from the terrorist. Despite the challenges, he maintained the surprise and reached close to the target house.

Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector deployed himself and his buddy to cover the most likely escape root of the terrorist. Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector along with his team evacuated the civilians to the safer place. Leading his team from the front he remained determined and showed nerves of steel. As he was advancing towards the target house, the hiding terrorist noticed the presence and lobbed grenades

on them, in which he and his buddy had a narrow escape.

Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector displaying utmost courage in the face of enemy, responded with controlled fire making the terrorist to run in another direction. Finding himself from other side also as the 2nd team of SOG, Valley QRT and 24-RR cornered the terrorist from other side of the house, the terrorist ran to take cover. The dreaded terrorist took cover behind a cemented structure and boundary walls of the target house and started firing indiscriminately.

Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector along with his buddy kept on engaging the terrorist and moved close to the terrorist. Finding Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector in close proximity, the terrorist fired heavily towards the officer. Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector, retaliated heavily and made him run for life. The other team of SOG, Valley QRT and 24-RR also retaliated and the terrorist was injured.

Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector realised that the terrorist is injured and decided to eliminate the terrorist. Shri Amit Raina, Asst. Sub-Inspector left his cover and without caring for his life, advanced towards the terrorist who was hiding behind a pillar and was retaliating effectively despite being injured and in a face-to-face gunfight with the terrorist neutralized him without any collateral damage.

Later on, the dead body of the killed terrorist was recovered from the scene of encounter and his identity was ascertained as foreign terrorist namely Hafiz @ Hamza @ Abu Ukasha R/o Pak, "A" category of LeT outfit.

			The operation was concluded without any collateral damage and the elimination of the said terrorists is a big jolt to the LeT terrorist network in South/ Central Kashmir Range. The killed terrorists namely Hafiz @ Hamza @ AbuUkasha R/o Pak "A" Category of LeT Outfit, was also involved in a number of terror attacks. Shri Amit Raina No. No.1116/S, PID No. EXK-022280, Asst. Sub-Inspector of Police Component, Srinagar, not only took front in elimination of the LeT
			Commander but also due to display of his exceptional and conspicuous bravery, indomitable will, passion to succeed and uphold the honour and integrity of the nation in the face of heavy odds and professional tactics attributed to the tremendous grit, determination and exemplary valour because of which the whole operation concluded successfully. Srinagar	J&K Police	On 03.01.2022 at around 1420 hours a specific input was received from reliable sources that terrorists possessing illegal arms/ammunition are roaming in a Shalimar Garden of District Srinagar. In order to get the proper identification of the terrorist immediately police teams of District Srinagar/ Police Component Srinagar/ Valley GAT CRPF were constituted to identify the exact location and to neutralize the

terrorist without any collateral damage.

It was learnt that LeT Commander Mohammad SaleemParray "A++ category" is present inside the Shalimar Garden. SaleemParray @ Billa was also known as Throatslitter and was responsible for killing 12 civilians and martyring 05 J&K Police personnel and 01 CRPF person beside injuring many. The teams of SOG Srinagar and valley discussed the plan for launching an operation inside the garden. After proper planning it was decided that to conceal the identity and maintain surprise and small teams consisting of SOG and Valley QRT will launch covert operation in civvies inside the garden. One small team headed by SI Faroz Ahmad Dar ARP995924 entered the garden from front side and another small team of SOG and Valley QRT from back side. The garden was full of civilians mostly women and children. The population of the civilian inside the garden was dense towards the starting and was thin towards the end.

Shri Faroz Ahmad Dar, SI along-with his buddy identified and located the position of the terrorist towards the end of the garden and advanced towards the terrorist. Sensing the presence of troops, the terrorist took out his weapon. Shri Faroz Ahmad Dar asked the terrorist to drop hisweapon and to surrender but he opened indiscriminate firing upon them and began running. However, the Police party immediately took laying position and had a miraculous escape.

Shri Faroz Ahmad Dar displaying utmost courage in the face of enemy responded with controlled

fire making the terrorist to run in another direction. Finding himself trapped from other side also as the 2nd team of SOG Srinagar and Valley GRT cornered the terrorist from other side, the terrorist ran to take cover. The dreaded terrorist took an advantageous position between a cemented structure and a tree with big trunk and started firing indiscriminately. Finding civilians mostly women and children under imminent threat of life, he left his cover amid the bullets fired by the terrorist and asked his buddy to give cover fire and without caring for his life moved towards the civilians and while reaching close to the civilians, shifted them to a concrete structure towards the centre of the garden. After shifting the civilians to a safer place, he along-with another team decided to eliminate the terrorist at the earliest.

Shri Faroz Ahmad Dar realized that terrorist is injured and decided to eliminate the terrorist. He left his cover without caring for his life, advanced towards the terrorist and in a face to face gun fight with the terrorist and neutralized him. Later on, the dead body of the killed terrorist was recovered from the scene of encounter and his identity was ascertained as Mohammad SaleemParray @ Billa, "A++ Categorized" terrorist of LeT Outfit along-with recovery of arms/ ammunition.

The operation was concluded without any collateral damage and the elimination of the said terrorist is a big jolt to the LeT terrorist network in South/ Central Kashmir Range. The above-mentioned neutralized terrorist was also

			involved in a number of terrorist related activities/ attacks in the Valley. Shri Faroz Ahmad Dar ARP995924 not only took front in elimination of the LeT Commander but also displayed his exceptional and conspicuous bravery, indomitable will, passion to succeed and uphold the honour and integrity of the nation in the face of heavy odds and professional tactics attributed to the tremendous grit, determination and exemplary valour because of which the whole operation concluded successfully.

Immediately, teams of Local Police Srinagar/PC Srinagar were constituted and CASO was launched in the area. While the CASO was being launched in target locality ChonchiFaqeer, Sangam Srinagar, terrorist/s hurled grenades amid indiscriminate firing upon the police parties with the intention to kill and escape from the area. The Police parties while taking all the precautions as per the SOPs, retaliated the fire bravely & effectively without caring for their personal lives. Meanwhile, Shri Varun Singh, Constable alongwith his team located the suspect in the locality and approached towards the terrorist from his side. The terrorist sensing presence of personnel moving towards him resorted to fire

upon Shri Varun Singh and his buddies. However, the official swiftly pulled down himself and his buddy down to laying position and this way Shri Varun Singh and his buddy had a narrow escape. Meantime, Shri Varun Singh retaliated and caused fire injury in the leg of running terrorist. During the course, he decided to eliminate the terrorist at the earliest and cornered the terrorist from his side who was taking cover behind the trees and in the exchange of the fire, dreaded terrorist was neutralized.

The dead body of the killed terrorist was recovered from the scene of encounter and later on identified as "Adil Ahmad Parray @ Abu Baker, an A- Category terrorist of LeT/ TRF outfit, Arms/ammunition was recovered from the possession of slain terrorist. The operation was concluded without any collateral damage and elimination of the terrorist is a big jolt to the LeT/ TRF terrorist network in Central Kashmir Range.

Shri Varun Singh, Constable not only took front in elimination of the LeT/TRF commander but also due to display of his exceptional and conspicuous bravery, indomitable and professional tactics will attributed to the tremendous grit, determination and exemplary courage, whole operation concluded successfully.
